

CNR Card Frequently Asked Questions

What's the difference between the accounts on my card?

Only Resident students receive **Food** accounts. These are a part of the room and board charges, and can only be used in the Food Court. Anyone can open an **Auxiliary** account which can be used anywhere that the CNR card is accepted.

May I let a friend use my CNR card?

No. The cafeteria will not accept cards from anyone other than the owner, and may confiscate the card. Also, do not allow anyone to use your card to gain access to a residence hall. This is an access violation, punishable by fine or judicial board action.

How do I know how much money is left on my card?

To find out your current food balance, just ask for a receipt of your cafeteria transaction or look at the register pole display. Your bookstore receipt will also display this information for the auxiliary account. If you are not sure that you have enough money left on your card to complete a transaction in the cafeteria, just ask the cashier to do a balance check before he or she rings you up. For a printout of your account activity, you may submit a request in writing to the Security Office.

Does the money roll over from semester to semester?

The food account is only valid for one semester at a time. Money in this account must be spent by the end of the semester or it is forfeited. The auxiliary account is valid for as long as a student is attending the college (or as long as a staff/faculty member is employed). If an account holder leaves the College, then the remaining balance is forfeited, but it is valid until that time.

What do I need to do to get my ID validated?

In order to have your ID validated, you must go to the Security Office during office hours. **YOU MUST BRING PROOF OF REGISTRATION WITH YOU.** If you are unable to come in between regular hours don't panic. The office is open late at the beginning of each semester. Look for fliers or call 654-5265 for details of extended hours.
