

RETURNING STUDENT CHECKLIST -- FALL 2009

- **CHANGES IN PLANS OR PERSONAL RECORDS:** Report any changes in your plans or personal records [online](#), or call

- **TUITION & FEES:** Prior to returning to campus, your bill must be paid in full or you must arrange to be on the Monthly Payment Plan.

- **HEALTH FORM:** All students must have a current form on file and an up-to-date immunization record.

- **LIBRARY:** Contact the Library to clear up any outstanding fines, or overdue or lost books.

- **CNR ID CARD:** All returning students must have their ID cards validated for the fall semester. Be sure to bring **PROOF OF REGISTRATION** to Security. If you would like to open an Auxiliary Services or Food Account, make arrangements through the Bursar or the Security Office.

- **COMMUTER STUDENTS:** If you plan to drive to campus, purchase your parking tag, beginning August 20th, in the Security Office between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. daily. Be sure to bring **PROOF OF REGISTRATION!**
