To be eligible for consideration for any of the following awards, SAS/SON Seniors must receive *at least two nominations* and **must have** a **Senior Data Form on file by February 25<sup>th</sup>**.

**PRESIDENT'S AWARD**

**Description:**

The President's Award, inaugurated in 1992 to commemorate the 20th Anniversary of the Presidency of Sr. Dorothy Ann Kelly, O.S.U., is presented to the graduate whose outstanding personal achievements and contributions to the College exemplify the highest ideals of The College of New Rochelle. Only ONE award will be presented.

**Criteria:** Cumulative G.P.A. of 3.5 or higher  
Senior Data Form on file and at least two nominations  
Demonstrated record of achievement, service and commitment to CNR

**Award:** Plaque

**CNR ALUMNAE/I ASSOCIATION AWARD**

**Description:**

This award from the CNR Alumnae/i Association is presented to the graduate whose record of accomplishment demonstrates outstanding service to the College community. ONE award will be presented FOR EACH SCHOOL.

**Criteria:** Cumulative G.P.A. of 2.8 or higher  
Senior Data Form on file and at least two nominations  
Demonstrated record of service to the College community  
Potential for future participation in Alumnae/i affairs

**Award:** Plaque

**COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD**

**Description:**

Originated by the Class of 1980, this award is given to a graduating senior who has exemplified outstanding service and leadership in the community. This award is focused on activities **OUTSIDE** The College of New Rochelle community. Only ONE award will be presented.

**Criteria:** Cumulative G.P.A. of 2.8 or higher  
Senior Data Form on file and at least two nominations  
Demonstrated record of service to community outside of CNR

**Award:** Plaque

## KATHLEEN GERVINO BECKER AWARD

**Description:**

This award was established in memory of a young woman of exceptional sensitivity and talent. It is presented to a graduating student who exemplifies these traits in recognition of the value of such creative persons in today's society.

**Criteria:** Cumulative G.P.A. of 2.8 or higher  
Senior Data Form on file and at least two nominations  
Demonstrated commitment to artistic or creative pursuits

**Award:** Monetary award funded by the family of Kathleen Gervino Becker

## WHO'S WHO

**Description:**

The College is invited to nominate graduating seniors for inclusion in this year's edition of Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges. This is a means of giving recognition to students of outstanding achievement, and serves as a reference in many libraries, businesses and governmental agencies. Up to 24 awards may be presented in each school.

**Criteria:** Cumulative G.P.A. of 2.8 or higher  
Senior Data form on file and at least two nominations  
Participation in college activities and organizations  
Service to the College community  
Service outside the College community  
Potential for future achievement

**Award:** Official Who's Who Certificate  
Inclusion in this year's edition of Who's Who (Option to purchase book)

## KAPPA GAMMA PI

**Description:**

This is a national Catholic service-oriented honor society, open to all denominations, with nominations limited to 10% of the graduating class. Up to 20 awards may be presented.

**Criteria:** Cumulative G.P.A. of 3.2 or higher  
Senior Data Form on file and at least two nominations  
Demonstrated outstanding leadership and performance in college

**Award:** Official Kappa Gamma Pi certificate and membership
