Please note that all students are required to obtain approval from an advisor prior to registering for classes.

\*PSY 585 students: Please note that prior to enrolling in PSY 585: Interviewing and Counseling Practicum, students must have completed at least 36 credits in the program including PSY 581, PSY 610 and PSY 685. Students must secure a site at least 30 days prior to enrolling in the course and MUST submit the Application for Practicum and the Placement Site Approval Form to Wendi Vescio in Chidwick 103 for approval prior to registration for the course. Students without the signature of Wendi Vescio will not be permitted to register for this course. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

\*PSY 710 students: Please also note that prior to enrolling in PSY 710: MHC Internship I, students must have completed at least 45 credits in the program including PSY 585. Note that students must secure a site at least 30 days prior to enrolling in the course and MUST submit the Application for Internship and Placement Site Approval Form to Wendi Vescio in Chidwick 103 prior to registration for the course. Students without the signature of Wendi Vescio will not be permitted to register for this course. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

\*PSY 711 students: In order to enroll in PSY 711: MHC Internship II, students must have completed at least 45 credits in the program including PSY 585 AND PSY 710. Note that students must secure a site at least 30 days prior to enrolling in the course and MUST submit the Application for Internship and Placement Site Approval Form to the Wendi Vescio in Chidwick 103 prior to registration for the course. Students without the signature of Wendi Vescio will not be permitted to register for this course. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.
